



1. **SCULPTURE: 'THE GATES OF HOSPITALITY'**

Šv. Jokūbo g.

This sculpture was erected in 2013 to commemorate the twenty-fifth anniversary of the founding of Sąjūdis (*Lithuania's reform movement*). The sculpture is in the shape of a Lithuanian horseshoe, which symbolises happiness, success, and the protection of the home from evil. The horseshoe incorporates symbols of happiness and success from neighbouring nations.

How many symbols of happiness and success are there on the horseshoe?



2. **DRUSKININKAI CITY MUSEUM**

M. K. Čiurlionio g. 59

This museum is housed in an impressive neo-Classical villa by the name of Linksma, which means 'fun'. It was built at the beginning of the twentieth century. The villa was once the summer residence of an aristocratic family of the Grand Duchy of Lithuania, which represented the Druskininkai resort in general. Today the museum and its terrace host concerts, exhibitions, and other cultural events, as well as marriage registrations.

3. **DRUSKININKAI ORTHODOX CHURCH**

Laisvės a. 1

This church was built in 1865. It is one of the oldest surviving wooden items of architecture in Druskininkai. The church's form features striking details which are typical of the Romantic and Historicism periods, as well as as unique and exceptional architectural elements.

4. **DRUSKININKAI HEALTH RESORT, OUTDOOR BUVETTE**

The buvette at the Health Resort Park is also known as the Druskininkai central mineral water buvette. Its windows are decorated with stained glass which was created by the artist, Kazys Morkūnas.

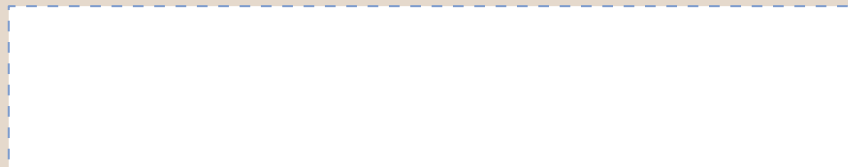

5. **M K ČIURLIONIS MONUMENT**

V. Kudirkos g. 45

Mikalojus Konstantinas Čiurlionis is the most famous of Lithuanian artists. He grew up and worked in Druskininkai, and spoke fondly of the resort in his letters. Did you know that as a child the artist was known as Kastukas?

6. **THE WATERLINE FOR THE 1958 SPRING FLOOD**

Health Resort Park

In the spring of 1958, Lithuania was struck by a flood of extraordinary proportions, one which also affected Druskininkai: the overflowing River Nemunas flooded the entire area where today stands the Health Resort Park and its buildings. The first person to mark the maximum height of the water level with a simple stick was a female physician who worked at the Health Resort Park and who reached that location in a simple boat. A symbolic plaque was later placed at the site.

Find the plaque which marks the height of the flood water in the Health Resort Park. What are the figures on it?

Health Resort Park, River Nemunas embankment

9. **RAMS SCULPTURE**

Turistų g. 1

This sculpture is located in the central recreation area in Vijūnėlė Park. This park is home to a sea of over half a million daffodils, as well as an avenue of twenty Japanese cherry trees.

10. **DRUSKININKAI CHURCH OF SAINT MARY'S SCAPULAR**

Vilniaus al. 1

Valentine's Day is celebrated around the world on 14 February. Today, not many people know that Druskininkai's church holds a very rare relic of Saint Valentine. A small bone of the saint is reverently placed in an ornate vessel - a reliquary.

Karolis Dineika, the 'Wizard from Druskininkai', did indeed perform health miracles: the main ingredients of his magic were sun, air, water, breathing, exercise, massage, and psycho-physical training. It is after him that the wellness park is named.

12. **THE BEND BRIDGE**

They quickly fell in love and she decided to run away with him.
